Description :

Politeknik Keselamatan Transportasi Jalan (PKTJ) Tegal is located in Tegal City, a coastal urban area on the northern coast of Central Java Province, Indonesia. Covering an area of 39.24 km² and divided into four districts and 27 urban villages, Tegal City recorded a population density of 7,461 people per km² in 2023, making it the second most densely populated city in Central Java after Surakarta.

PKTJ is a state polytechnic under the Ministry of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia, dedicated to road transportation safety education. It was established on 14 May 1971 as the Road Transportation Education and Training Center (Balai Diklat Trans Jaya) and officially inaugurated on 27 September 1971 by the Director General of Land Transportation, Sumpono Bayuaji.

The institution currently operates two campuses within Tegal City. Campus 1 (Perintis) is situated at Jl. Perintis Kemerdekaan No. 17, East Tegal District, on the former PJKA (SCS) warehouse site. Campus 2 (Margadana) is located in Margadana District, Tegal City, and serves as the center for practical and technical training activities.

PKTJ Tegal offers three study programs: the Bachelor of Applied Science (D4) in Road Transportation System Engineering (RSTJ), the D4 in Automotive Engineering Technology (TRO), and the Diploma (D3) in Automotive Technology. All programs adopt a semi-military vocational education system that emphasizes character development and practical competencies in road safety, traffic engineering, and vehicle technology.
